**VERBATTLE SENIOR NATIONAL 2022 ONLINE DEBATE COMPETITION**

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

1. Entry is for students in the age **group of 18-24 years and pursuing undergraduate and postgraduate courses in various streams**. The relaxation in age is up to a maximum of 30 days on either limit of age.
2. A team would consist of **two participants** only.
3. A team is identified by its College & Student names.
4. The declaration of results shall be final and binding on all participants and no dispute shall be entertained subsequently under any circumstance.
5. **Registration fee per team is INR.1000/- and payable by online transfer / NEFT / Google pay in favour of Verbattle Foundation.**
6. All decisions with regard to the content, scope and structure of the event shall vest with the organisers only. And, all such decisions shall be final and binding on all participants of the event.
7. In case of non-participation by the participants in the team, the team would be disentitled to claim any other opportunity or chance and the entry fee paid by such individual or team shall stand forfeited.
8. The facts and information submitted in the participation registration as also information furnished by the participants shall be self attested by the participants. It shall be presumed that the participants have obtained permission from their parents / guardians to participate in the competition and have understood the inherent terms and risks of participating in the competition.
9. Rules of the participation in the various rounds of the competition shall be provided along with the format of the qualifying rounds up to the finals, from time to time. This will be based on the format already announced and available as part of the competition and shall be in use in the event of any minor modification or generic adjustment that may have to be made to adapt to technology or the limitations of it. ( Every related information is available on the website. If there is any confusion, the same may be clarified by writing to the office of Verbattle
10. All payments have to be made via online transfer. DD / cheque/ Cash can be accepted on a case to case basis with validity and clearance dates being assured well before the commencement of the competition. DD/Cheque to be drawn in favour of Verbattle Foundation, payable at Bengaluru. Any cash payment without receipt is at the risk of the payer.

11. Should any information be discovered to be incorrect, the organizers reserve the right to disqualify such team and to deny or withhold participation and the entry fee will be forfeited. The decision of the organizers in this regard would be final and binding.

12. Any unacceptable or indecent behavior by the participants will invite immediate disqualification for the team.

13. Registration Fees once paid will not be paid back under any circumstance and is not transferable. However, the same will be refunded if the team is found ineligible or disqualified, after making the registration fee payment and before commencement of the event.

In the event of cancellation of the event due to any incident beyond the control of the organizers, including but not limited to natural calamities, political unrest, COVID-19 lockdown etc. the fees shall not be refunded but may be adjusted against the next event conducted by the organizers. However, such adjustment of fees paid shall be at the discretion and to the organizers to be valid.

14. In case of the results of the debate, the decision of the judges will be final in consultation with the chief moderator/nominated representative. No dispute and disagreement will be entertained thereafter.

The Chief Moderator or any other designated moderator may cancel a debate, restructure a debate, reassign statements, or even stop a debate midway or may even interrupt if need be, in the interest of the spirit and conduct of the competition with or without any explanation or justification. Such a decision by the moderator should be accepted, respected and adhered to by the concerned teams and other participants.

15. The participant should be prepared to endure criticism, defeat or unpleasant comments by any person during the tournament. Any injury or other bodily distress inflicted by any participant upon himself/herself shall be deemed to have arisen from a failure of either the participants or the parents or of the institution (or all) by not ascertaining the risks the attendant faces in such competitions/ tournaments. All participants, their parents or guardians and the concerned institution hereby agree to hold the organizers of the /competition/tournament as well as the sponsors, judges and other persons involved with the competition/tournament immune from any claim that may be brought in respect of any emotional or physical injury or distress suffered by any participant.

16. Filming/recording of the event and also showing some participants or debate is entirely the discretion of the producer in charge of producing the video post the online activity irrespective of its streaming and availability on any platform. No participant can claim the right to be or not to be recorded, filmed, streamed, visually documented to be shown on TV or any other medium. Verbatle reserves the right to use any recorded visuals from the event or the event location for its own purpose.

Any dispute arising out of the competition, refund, or any other dispute shall be subject solely to courts at Bengaluru.

17. All participants will be issued a digital / online certificate for their highest level of participation. A hard/physical copy may be obtained by any participant through a special request by bearing the postal/courier charges.

18. Any technical issues faced at the participants' end which might prevent them from fully or partially participating in their allotted debate / which might prevent other teams to complete the designated rounds / which might result in the judges or moderator being unable to listen or follow the delivery of debates with reasons notwithstanding internet connectivity / internet speed / audio (sound) / camera & light, background & location noise or disturbance or any other specific or nonspecific situation will not be the liability of Verbattle in any manner and Verbattle shall retain its right to reschedule or retain the round / debate and/or allow the round to proceed without the participation of such team member / team that might have the technical issue.

19. Depending on the stage/level of the competition, Verbattle, as per its discretion, may decide to go ahead with a debate/debate round, with a minimum of 2 teams and/or judges may be impressed upon to award their scores based on prior performance and/or the entire debate may be rescheduled with or without a change in statement.

20. Since the online format is exclusively dependent on clear visuals and also an uncompromising quality and clarity of sound, speech and volume, the moderator, in consultation with judges and other participants, reserves the right to allow the commencement / continued participation of any team member / team/s, and such action may result in a nominal provision of time for the same to be resolved, rescheduling of the event.

21. Time allotted for debates shall strictly be followed with login by respective teams at least 10 minutes prior. Delay in logging in / non-compliance of the rules of the format such as keeping the cameras on, maintaining sound hygiene, avoiding visual disturbance, strictly disallowing any 3rd party on screen or an audio, are to be strictly avoided.

22. Reading out from the screen or any reference material is to be strictly avoided. Indulgence in the same will attract deduction in marks. Repeated practice of the same may lead up to the team being disqualified from the said round / competition.

23. Use of any un-parliamentary words and unauthorized engagement with any participant / coordinator / official / judges will attract immediate disqualification of the student / team / school.

24. Any objection / argument / difference of opinion / issue taken up, direct or other, by any representative of the team either during / after the event that may come in the way of the smooth conduct of the event ; or raise any question about the integrity of the event shall be treated with utmost seriousness and action will be taken leading up to restricting the team from further participation to its dismissal, disallowing any further participation for the respective team member/s and the institution.

**25. Event prize money of Rs.20000/- to the Winning team and Rs.5000/- to each finalist team will be paid in 120 days of announcement of final result and the same shall be processed by way of cheque / bank transfer exclusively in the names of the prize winning students.**

26. Prize money is only an incentive and not the sole purpose of the event or participation in the event. The liability of the organisers is within the limitation of the bonafide intention of conducting the event.
