VERBATTLE RULES AND REGULATION (TO BE READ BEFORE SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION)

1. Entry is only for school teachers.
2. Teams are only permitted to represent their respective schools. Independent teams shall not be permitted to participate in the competition.
3. In case of more than one team per school, the team will have a suffix from 'A'-'B' depending on the number. A school may have a maximum of two teams in representation. This rule could be relaxed in special circumstances at the sole discretion of the organizers.
4. A team shall consist of two participants only. The same participants shall continue as a team throughout the competition.
5. The facts and information submitted in the participation registration as also information furnished by the participants shall be verified by the head of the respective institutions / authorised official and attested as true and correct.
6. There is no entry fee or any other financial contribution for registration as individuals/ as teams/ as school.
7. Each Team shall submit a duly filled up application form with correct and accurate details mentioned
8. Participants are required to be present carrying their school ID cards for the competition. Failure to do so might result in denial of participation.
9. The declaration of results shall be final and binding on all participants and no change shall be entertained under any circumstance.
10. The competition shall be conducted in English.
11. All decisions with regard to the content, scope and structure of the event shall vest with the organisers only. And, all such decisions shall be final and binding on all participants.
12. Rules of the participation in the various rounds of the competition shall be provided along with the format of the qualifying rounds up to the finals, from time to time.
13. Should any information be discovered to be incorrect, the organizers reserve the right to disqualify such team and to deny or withhold participation / prize money / any prize or gift to any participant at any level of the competition. The decision of the organisers in this regard would be final and binding.
14. Any unacceptable or indecent behaviour by the participants or their supporters will invite immediate disqualification for the team.
15. The Chief Moderator or any other designated moderator may cancel a debate, restructure a debate, reassign statements, or even stop a debate midway or may even interrupt if need be, in the interest of the spirit and conduct of the competition with or without any explanation or justification. Such a decision by the moderator should be accepted, respected and adhered to by the concerned teams and other participants.
16. The organizers shall not be responsible for any reimbursement/compensation for travel, accommodation or any other expense incurred by the participants, including in cases of cancellation/change of dates of the event.
17. In case of the results of the debate, the decision of the judges will be final in consultation with the chief moderator/designated moderator. No dispute and disagreement will be entertained thereafter.
18. The participant should be prepared to endure criticism, defeat or unpleasant comments by any person during the competition. Any injury or other bodily distress inflicted by any participant upon himself/herself shall be deemed to have arisen from a failure of either the participant, team member or of the institution (or all three) by not ascertaining the risks the attendant faces in such competitions/ championships. All participants and the concerned institution hereby agree to hold the organizers of the competition/championship as well as the sponsors, judges and other persons involved with the competition/ championship in respect of any emotional or physical injury or distress suffered by any participant.
19. Travel & Stay, if provided, will be according to Verbatlle norms. Participant opting for such service or making their own arrangements will be at their own risk. Verbatlle does not take any responsibility for any injury, medical condition, or any other incident which may occur in the accommodation provided to the participants, if any.
20. The Teams and participants shall be responsible for their own belongings and Verbatlle shall not be held responsible for any loss, theft or damage to personal belongings.
21. Accommodation would be facilitated only to outstation participants upon request.
22. Food, if provided, will be on the basis of the registration category - local and outstation. The food shall be hygienically prepared which would be healthy and nutritious.
23. Filming the event and also showing some participants or debate is entirely the discretion of the production team. No participant can claim the right to be filmed and/ or visually documented to be shown on any medium. Verbatlle reserves the right to use any recorded audio-visuals or still photographs from the event or the event location for its own purposes.
24. Any dispute arising out of the competition, refund, or any other dispute shall be subject solely to courts at Bengaluru.
25. The organizers may at their discretion provide all participants with badges for the purposes of identity. All participants are required to clearly display their badges at all times during the competition and at places of accommodation.
26. Adequate security measures shall be undertaken by the organizers. However, the participants are expected to maintain decorum. The organizers shall not be held responsible for any untoward incident occurring due to any direct or indirect irresponsible act of any participant.
27. Participants should abide by all security requirements.
28. The organizers and security team should be kept informed about any movement out of campus by the Participants.
29. The Prize money for the competition will be issued by cheque/transfer to individual winners. The same will be processed within 120 working days of the completion of the event and it will be subject to any tax or deductions, if any, at the time of disbursement. Certificates will be issued to the participants as determined by the organizers.
30. Prize money is only an incentive and not the sole purpose of the event or participation in the event. The liability of the organisers is within the limitation of the bonafide intention of conducting the event.
31. If an on stage event cannot continue for any reason what so ever, the same will be converted to online platform and continued with due intimation.
32. Any clarification, complaint, or query during the event should be made only by / through the school. Verbatlle will not entertain any direct engagement with any participant regarding the competition.
33. Any objection with regard to any teams on the stage during a debate shall be taken up only during that debate or before all three teams get off the stage.
